## **2010 CAMP PROGRAM**

### **July 5&6 &/or 8&9 Recreational Horse Camp**

This camp will offer general horsemanship skills, review basic ring riding skills, introduce and experience basic trail riding and trail obstacles. This camp is a great opportunity for your not so serious rider as well as the very anxious beginner who has not done a horse camp before and wants to learn. We will also be offering more advanced barn and horse care technique.

### **July 12&13 Dressage Camp**

All levels are invited to this camp, as riders will be able to ride at their appropriate level and above to enhance their understanding and ability of the Dressage world.

### **July 15&16 Stadium Jumping**

Open to all level riders. We will be explaining the concepts of stadium course design and riding stadium course design and riding stadium courses from 18" - 3' 3".

### **July 20, 21 & 22 Combined Training Camp**

Introduction to key elements of riding in a combined training competition from the basic rules to the course design will be discussed, demonstrated and ridden. This camp will allow those wishing to try this type of competition through the novice/training. Providing a good foundation to enable riders to be confident in this field.

### **July 26th Introductory to Cross Country Jumping Camp**

This camp will offer all beginners an opportunity to experience the cross-country phase of horse trials at the introductory level.

### **August 3 Derby Cross Camp**

This camp is designed to introduce all elements of the new and innovative riding sport of Derby Cross. This sport combines the speed and accuracy of show jumping with the bravery and endurance of Cross Country jumping. Basic stadium and cross country skills are needed to participate. Check with your instructor before signing up.

### **August 9, 10 & 11 3 Phase/Horse Trials/Eventing Camp**

This camp will allow students who have solid advanced beginner through novice level skills an opportunity to explore and ride all three elements of a horse trial. A great opportunity to prep and build confidence to compete in this type of competition.
